Preamble: -

Superintendent of Police, Gadchiroli has submitted a proposal for Diversion of 2.00 ha. Forest Land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Construction of Administrative Building and Residential Quarters for Officers and Police Staff at Nender (Camp Aldandi), Tal-Ettapalli, Dist-Gadchiroli to the State Forest Department. Government of Maharashtra, vide its Government Resolution under reference no.2 has accorded 'in-principle' approval to the proposal. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur, vide letter referred at Sr.No.3 has submitted a compliance report of the conditions mentioned in 'in-principle' approval letter.

Resolution: -

1. In exercise of powers delegated to the State Governments, vide Government of India's order no. F.No.11-9/98/FC, dated 13.05.2011 and dated 16.06.2011, Government of Maharashtra vide it's Resolution referred at Sr. No. 2 has granted '**in-principle'** approval to the Diversion of 2.00 ha. Forest Land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Construction of Administrative Building and Residential Quarters for Officers and Police Staff at Nender (Camp Aldandi), Tal-Ettapalli, Dist-Gadchiroli.

3. This sanction is issued subject to the following conditions-

- 1. The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2. The forest land shall not be used for any purposes other than specified in the project.
- 3. The User Agency will defray the additional / revised cost of Net Present Value of Forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India, if required.
- 4. It will be the responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the labour's, staff engaged in construction activity do not damage nearby forest flora and fauna.
- 5. Provisions of all Acts, Rules made there under and guidelines applicable to the project shall have to be strictly followed.
- 6. This sanction is granted subject to the compliance of the conditions mentioned in the in-principle approval letter, any other conditions stipulated by the Government time to time. It is mandatory to the User Agency to comply all these conditions.
- 7. The User Agency shall comply with all the conditions stipulated in the 'in-principle' and 'final / formal approval' orders of Government of Maharashtra. The Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial), Gadchiroli shall ensure the strict compliance of the conditions by the User Agency and he will furnish the report in this regard to Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur from time to time.

- 8. The actual diversion of forest land shall be effected by the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Gadchiroli after compliance of all the conditions by the User Agency.
- 9. Non-compliance of any of the conditions mentioned in this order and Rules and Guidelines made / issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, shall amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken accordingly. In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the concerned Chief Conservator of Forests / Deputy Conservator of Forests shall report through the State Government to Regional Officer (Central), Integrated Regional Office, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Nagpur as per procedure laid down under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
