I enclose herewith a copy of the letter cited along with statutory proforma proposal under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, submitted by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh for diversion of 118.30 Ha. of forest land for establishment of Eco-tourism Village under Capital City Infrastructure Development Projects in Pedamaddur Forest Block, Guntur Division & District of Andhra Pradesh, in favour of Andhra Pradesh of Andhra Pradesh, in favour of Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority.

2. I wish to inform that the user agency i.e. Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority (APCRDA) has justified that the degraded forest lands are strategically located in the identified growth corridors of the capital region. Further, there is no land bank available with the district administration and the APCRDA pooled up an area of 34,500 acres from the farmers of nearby Capital City. After exhausting all alternative lands in the unavoidable circumstances, the degraded forest land is identified for the purpose of the project for creating economic growth in the Capital Region. The User agency has submitted undertaking to bear the cost of raising and maintenance of compensatory afforestation as per the prevailing wage rates at the time of undertaking the plantation activities, for payment of Net Present Value (NPV), additional NPV and tree extraction charges in the forest land proposed for diversion.

3. The District Collector, Guntur has issued necessary certificates under Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, as stipulated by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi vide Lr.No.11-9/1998-FC (pt), Dt.05.07.2013, in the prescribed format Annexure-I (Form-I) for evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights. The concerned field officers and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, have recommended the proforma proposal in Part-II, III and IV respectively. The recommendation in the proforma proposal in Part-V is enclosed herewith.

I request you to obtain and communicate the approval of Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of 118.30 Ha. of forest land for stablishment of Eco-tourism Village under Capital City Infrastructure Development Projects in Pedamaddur Forest Block, Guntur Division & District of Andhra Pradesh, in favour of Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority, at an early date.
