The Executive Director, National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad is aware that the Inspector General of Forests (Central) Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Vijayawada in the reference 2nd cited has communicated In-principle / Stage-I approval of Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act,1980 for diversion of 0.39 ha of forest land falling in compartment no.10 in Yekuvuru RF, of Kasibugga Range of Srikakulam Division for laying sea water inlet pipeline from sea to the NFDB (National Fisheries Development Board) site at Mulapolam in favour of Executive Director, National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad.

In this connection, the user agency has to pay the cost of Net present value, Cost of raising of plantations (including raising and maintenance for 10 years), Mitigation measure charges, Extraction and transport of 230 trees from felling point to Government sale Depot as per the conditions stipulated in the stage-I approval accorded by the Government of India. Hence, a demand notice is prepared as per the

instructions issued by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Guntur in the reference 4th cited and enclosed herewith to transfer/remit Rs.15.26591 lakhs to Adhoc CAMPA account and Rs.0.030 lakhs for departmental extraction of trees and furnish counterfoils to this office for further process.

It is further requested to furnish the condition wise compliance report for the Stage-I approval accorded by the Government of India, M.o.E.F, IRO, Vijayawada vide Rc.No.F.no.4-APB164/2022-Vij/312, dt: 30.04.2022 and also for the following conditions as per the instructions issued by the Government of India in F.No.7-23/2012-Forest Conservation Act, 1980, dt: 24.07.2013. Copy of Government of India IRO, Vijayawada letter Rc.No.F.no.4-APB164/2022-Vij/312, dt: 30.04.2022 and Prl.C.C.F.,A.P. Guntur Rc.No. EFS02-15027/3/2020-FCA-SEC PCCF/FCA-3, dt: 16.05.2022 are enclosed herewith.

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the
 conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two
 widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and another
 in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted
 to the project proponent for use of forest land for non forestry purposes.
- 2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn have to display the same for 30 days.

The compliance for the above conditions shall be furnished to this office immediately, so as to submit the same to the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Guntur through Chief Conservator of Forests, Visakhapatnam to get the final approval at the earliest.

I (a) Procedure for e-challan generation:

- i. On issue of this demand notice, the user agency shall log into Forest clearance portal *forestsclearance.nic.in* to generate e-challan and make payment against the demand.
- ii. Agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer i.e., Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Guntur for verification.
- iii. Once it is verified by Nodal Officer, Agency can generate e-challan from the portal.

I (b) procedure for payment through RTGS:

- iv. For payment through RTGS, the representative of the agency ie., Executive Director, National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed e-challan with an Account Number printed on it.
- v. While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
- vi. Upon executing the RTGS by the sender / remitter bank, the amount collected will be credited to relevant CAMPA state account with the Bank on real time basis.
