It is to inform that the Government of Telangana vide reference 6th cited has issued In Principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 0.6383 Ha of forest land i.e., 0.0654 Ha in Mulugu Division and 0.5729 Ha in WLM Eturnagaram Division under Mulugu District in favour of M/s Jio Digital Fibre Limited, Hyderabad and the same is communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 7th cited above, with instructions to raise the demand notice over the M/s Jio Digital Fibre Limited, Hyderabad (user agency) in consultation with Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal (CCF) and Nodal Officer (FCA) for payment of compensatory levies by user agency (UA); obtain the compliance report from UA and furnish through CCF for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval.

Accordingly, the demand notice to be raised over the User Agency is prepared and the details are as follows:

The User Agency will be directed to deposit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc., into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., http://parivesh.nic.in by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-bystep process is available at http://parivesh.nic.in.

Further it is submitted that, as per the Circular instructions vide PCCF, TS HYD, Rc. No. 03/2015/FCA-1, 13.09.2017 erecting of Reinforced cement concrete pillars have been calculated and the charges has to be paid by the user agency in Forest Divisional Officer, Mulug, SBH Mulug Ac. No. 39872722946 IFSC Code. SBHY0020157. The details of demand notice is as shown below.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

- a) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- b) The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage I approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II approval.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

Therefore, the user agency i.e., Mrs. JIO Digital Fibre Limited is requested to submit condition-wise compliance report with documentary evidence together with press clipping publishing the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent and ensure that (4) sets of condition-wise compliance together with calculation sheet of payments details, undertakings, press clippings etc., shall be received in this office so as to forward the same to the higher authorities for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval from the competent authority.
