**Subject: Diversion of 1.33 ha. of forest land in Compartment No. 409 & 411 of Bagga beat of Kotturu Section of Pathapatnam Range of Srikakulam Division for formation of road from Pandra road 2/4 to Thumbali in favor of Executive Engineer, PR(PIU) Division, Palakonda- Reg.**

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letter Nos. 379/Section.II/2021 Dated 15.03.2021 and 379/Section.II/2021/(1353247) Dated: 03.06.2022 and online proposal No. FP/AP/ROAD/65068/2020 seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of forest land in accordance with Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above mentioned project.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am to convey the Central Government's in principle approval (**Stage-I**) under Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of **1.33 ha.** of forest land in Compartment No. 409 & 411 of Bagga beat of Kotturu Section of Pathapatnam Range of Srikakulam Division for formation of road from Pandra road 2/4 to Thumbali in favor of Executive Engineer, PR(PIU) Division, Palakonda, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;
- (ii) Demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of the User Agency;
- (iii) The State Forest Department shall carry out required CA activities, if possible over an extent of **1.46 ha (within 32.30 ha)** of non forest area Surjini Village, Srikakulam District, at the cost of the User Agency and Compensatory Afforestation and its maintenance shall be carried out over an extent of **1.46 ha (out of 34.74 ha)** of degraded Forest area in Compt No 263 of Jadupalii Forest Block of Pathapatnam Range, at the cost of the User Agency;

- (iv) The Non forest area and degraded forest area identified for CA purpose and CA scheme shall not be changed without prior approval of the Central Government. The CA land shall be demarcated properly and local villagers are adequately sensitized regarding the transfer of non forest land to Forest Department so as to avoid encroachments;
- (v) CA area as to be apportioned project wise and project wise demarcation has to be made in the field for the purpose of easy identification and monitoring purpose;
- (vi) **Kml file of the 34.74 ha of degraded Forest area identified for CA purpose (for 8 road projects) in Compt No 263 of Jadupalii Forest Block of Pathapatnam Range shall be submitted along with the compliance report;**
- (vii) Entire non-forest land identified over an extent of **32.30 ha** of non forest area in Surjini Village, Srikakulam District for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department and shall notified as RF/ PF before issue of the Stage-II clearance. **Copy of such notification shall be submitted along with the compliance report;**
- (viii) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring **1.33 ha** from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos.826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and Ministry's guideline No. 5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022 and clarification issued vide letter dated 22.03.2022;
- (ix) Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect;
- (x) All the funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>);
- (xi) **No tree felling shall be carried out in the diverted forest area;**
- (xii) **In few stretches, the proposed road alignment is deviated from the existing road, hence, left out portion of the existing road shall be restored by planting local tree species at the cost of the User Agency;**



- (xiii) The User Agency shall construct retaining walls and check walls wherever required, by consulting the DFO concerned, at the project cost;
- (xiv) Construction of culverts/bridges, if any, over the natural streams/rivers/canals shall be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, and also does not hamper movement of wild animals;
- (xv) Roadside cuttings and fillings which require engineering support shall be provided as per the instructions of the DFO concerned so as to stabilize the soil;
- (xvi) The dug out material / overburden shall be dumped outside the forest area. Storage of any material shall not be done in the forest area;
- (xvii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
- (xviii) The User Agency shall provide fire wood preferably alternate fuel to labourers working at the site to avoid damage/tree felling and no labour camp shall be established inside the forest area;
- (xix) Disturbance shall be kept minimum by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it shall be the responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna;
- (xx) The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed **1.33 ha (including existing pathway) and BT portion shall be restricted to 3.75 mtrs** and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect;
- (xxi) The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government;
- (xxii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- (xxiii) The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project;



- (xxiv) Any other conditions that the Central Government or Regional Officer (Central) of Integrated Regional Office, Vijayawada may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the User Agency;
- (xxv) In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the User Agency is liable for penal action as per the provisions under rules / guidelines issued under FCA, 1980.
- (xxvi) The State Government shall process and submit compliance report on the above conditions through online(<https://parivesh.nic.in/>);

After receipt of the compliance report on above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this letter. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after 5 years.
