14. Recommendation of the State Government:

The proposal is recommended for diversion of forest land measuring 20.10889 ha of forest land for settlement of Bru migrants in Paschim Kalajhari RF mouja under Karbook Sub-Division, Gomati District in the interest of public and other development activities. *The diversion proposal may be approved with the following conditions as proposed by DFO, Gomati:*

- Special care should be taken for wildlife animals during construction / creation of settlement.
- Chainlink fencing on either side of the approach road and main plot will be necessary so, funds for 10(ten) km chainlink fencing should be deposited to DFO, Gomati.
- Joint Forest Management Plan should be followed as attached JFMC office building cum multi utility centre should be constructed at the cost of 20 lakhs and other cost will be 30 lakh. So the User Agency should provide fund of 50 lakh for this purpose.
- Joint Forest Management Plan in respect of the area around proposed forest land for diversion for resettlement of Bru refugees at paschim Kalajhari RF under Tirthamukh Range under Gomati Tripura District.
- As the area proposed for diversion is located in such a place where not much human population pressure is there on the forest. However, after the resettlement of Bru refugees, Forest protection around the area would be a great challenge. In order to deal with this issue, a JFMC could be constituted by taking on board all the members of Bru refugees thereby involving them in the management and protection of the Forests around their settlement. Given below is the component of funds for achieving the aims and objective of the plan:-

5	Construction of Soil and Moisture Conservation Structures	10.0
6	Awareness Generation among JFMC members	1.5
7	Income Generation activities (Revolving Fund)	5.0
8	Entry point activities	5.0
9	Construction of office cum multi-utility centre	15.0

The fund required is basic minimum and indispensable and the user agency must provide it for the overall protection of the forest in and around the area proposed for diversion.
