Adverting to the references cited above, it is informed that vide reference 14<sup>th</sup> cited, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) while enclosing stage-I (in-principle) approval accorded by the GoIMoEF&CC, IRO, Hyderabad U/s 2 of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for diversion of **0.624 Ha** of Forest Land of for construction of six lane elevated corridor from Km7.950 (Uppal) to Km 14.200 (CPRI) of NH-163 (Uppal) to de-congest the Urban Limits of Hyderabad - Bhoopalapatnam Section on EPC mode in favour of Chief Engineer, Regional Officer, Hyderabad, MoRTH, GoI, in ref 13<sup>th</sup> cited, subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein has requested to submit the demand note to Nodal Officer (FCA) on email for vetting and only after vetting of the demand, the DFO should raise demand with the User Agency for making compensatory levies; and also to obtain the compliance report on conditions stipulated and furnish the same

As seen from the conditions stipulated in Stage-I (in-principle) approval, the demand notice to be issued to the user agency for compliance of the following conditions:

Hence, the User Agency has to deposit the funds into respective account indicated in the table. To deposit the funds into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account, the User Agency will be directed the same **through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.**

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

The user agency will be requested to comply with the other conditions as directed in the reference 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> cited and submit the compliance report alongwith all the required relevant information/documents etc. on the conditions stipulated by GoIMoEF&CC, IRO, Hyderabad in Stage I approval for obtaining Stage II (final) approval.

The UA will be requested not to carry out any work in violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 without
