विषय:- Diversion of 2.044 ha forest land in favour of Executive Engineer, irrigation and Water Resources Deptt., Bond Water Service Division, Bhiwani for remodeling of Dadri Distributory from RD 0 to 67120 off taking from RD 42700 Dadri Feeder, under forest division and District Charkhi Dadri, Haryana (online proposal no. FP/HR/Irrig/45499/2020).

महोदय,

कृपया उपर्युक्त विषय से संदर्भित पत्र का अवलोकन करें जिसमें वन (संरक्षण) अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा-२ के अधीन अनुमति मांगी गई है।

2. राज्य सरकार के प्रस्ताव का ध्यानपूर्वक अध्ययन करने के पश्चात उपर्युक्त विषय हेतु **2.044** हेक्टेयर वन भूमि के उपयोग के लिए **सैधांतिक स्वीकृति** निम्नलिखित शर्तों को पूरी करने पर प्रदान की जाती है।

(A) Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

- i) Cost of compensatory afforestation as per scheme may be realized from the user agency.
- ii) Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be realized from the user agency, as per Ministry's directions issued vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 5th February 2009 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 30th October 2002, 28th March, 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008;
- iii) As per the orders of the Government of India vide letter No. 5-2/2010-CAMPA 24.06.2011, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land and all other CA levies shall be deposited through web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change www.parivesh.nic.in.
- iv) User agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV, etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.

- v) **The Divisional Forest Officer shall furnish undertaking that the approved CA site(s) will not be changed without the approval of competent authority.**
- vi) **The CEO State CAMPA shall furnish undertaking that the funds under State CAMPA will be released to Divisional Forest Officer as per approved CA scheme.**
- vii) User Agency shall ensure that no other proposal in the division, for which Stage-I has already been granted in the past, is still pending for compliance of conditions of Stage-I approval. An Undertaking to this effect that "no such proposal for compliance of conditions of Stage-I approval is pending with this division" be submitted. Compliance of the same will be mandatory for the final clearance of this proposal by this office.
- viii) Original copy of FRA certificate to be submitted.
- ix) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

(B) Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:

- i) Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii) Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees not to exceed 296 trees.
- iii) The trees should be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- iv) The CA will be carried out over 4.088 ha on degraded forest land as per the CA scheme and the funds will be provided by the user agency. The plantation will be done within one year from the date of issue of the approval;
- v) The CEO, State CAMPA Authority shall ensure release of funds under CAMPA to the DFO for raising CA plantation as per CA scheme approved by this office;
- vi) The DFO shall ensure taking up CA plantations at approved CA sites and shall not alter the approved sites without obtaining the permission of the competent authority;
- vii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- viii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- ix) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- x) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;

- xi) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;
- xii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
- xiii) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India; and
- xiv) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.

4. उपरोक्त पैरा-2 के अधीन शर्तों की अनुपालना रिपोर्ट प्राप्त होने के उपरान्त वन संरक्षण अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा-2 के अधीन अन्तिम स्वीकृति के लिये प्रस्ताव पर विचार किया जायेगा। केन्द्रीय सरकार की अन्तिम अनुमति दिये जाने तक वन भूमि का उपयोग नहीं किया जायेगा।
