With reference to the subject and reference cited above, it is informed that, in exercise of the powers delegated to the State Government by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi in the reference 4th cited, the State Government vide GO 6th cited, have accorded in principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of forest land to an extent of 0.0859 Ha in Jannaram Forest Division of Mancherial District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/s.
