Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the Road Proposals received from the User Agency i.e., Executive Engineer Panchayati Raj, Paderu for the road proposed from Duppiliwada to Gorrilova via Kommulawada in G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 10/10/14

Inspected the proposed road from Duppiliwada to Gorilova on 10-10-2014 accompanied with Forest Range Officer, Sileru and Asst. Executive Engineer, PR, G.K. Veedhi. The said proposed road is kutcha road using by the villagers for their daily movement. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road with GPS readings N:17.97836 E.082.05660 and ends at N:18.02063 E.082.09321. The proposed road width is 7 m. and out of 7,600 m. of total length of the road, 3,794.13 m. length is passing through Compt. no.1541,1554 of Gudem R.L. & 1067 of Sileru R.L. with a diversion of 2.66 ha. There is 5 tree species falling along the width of Road proposed which are enumerated and enclosed to the proposal. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is less than 0.1. There are podulands and cultivable lands on either side of the proposed road. There are no valuable forest species on the proposed road, except 5 trees species. The villagers of Gorrilova and Kommulawada have requested for this road for their day to day movement to hospitals and schools for their children and for marketing their agricultural products. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological heritage importance in this locality.
