Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the Road Proposals received from the User Agency i.e., Executive Engineer Panchayati Raj, Paderu for the road proposed from Pothavaram to Mattam Bhimavaram in Koyyuru Mandal on 29/10/2014

Inspected the proposed road from Pothavaram to Mattam Bhimavaram on 29-10-2014 accompanied with Forest Range Officer, Marripakala and Asst. Executive Engineer, PR, Koyyuru. The said proposed road is forest coupe road existing with 3.5 to 4.0 m. width. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road with GPS readings N:17.78606 E.081.90234 and ends at N:17.77658 E.081.93643. The proposed road width is 7 m. and out of 4,600 m. of total length of the road, 3,044.88 m. length is passing through Compt. no.1448,1449 & 1451 of Puttakota R.L. with a diversion of 2.14 ha. There are 55 trees falling along the width of the road proposed which are enumerated and enclosed to the proposal. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the road varies from 0.1 to 0.4. The villagers of Mattam Bhimavaram have requested for this road since decades and they are suffering for their day to day movement to hospitals and schools for their children and for marketing their agricultural products. It is essential for improvement to the existing forest road to improve the life style of the poor tribals who are living far from the main stream. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological heritage importance in this locality.
