Site Inspection Report

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, Anand R & B Division Anand for permission for diversion (under FCA) of 0.9 ha of forest land for non forestry purpose i.e. for Construction of new ROB on Nadiad- Petlad- Khambhat Road .k.m. 24/500 to 25/500(L.C.No.28 Railway Crossing)Anand District in the state of gujarat The site inspection of the land involved in the proposed had been done by me on Dt.: 24/11/2015.

On inspection of the site it is found that the land required by the user agency is a PF forest admeasuring **0.9 ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the agency in Col.2 of part-I is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project.
