Umred – Karhandala WLS has blessed with rich biodiversity more than 35 mammals, 200 Birds, 80 Butterflies & many varietiesn of micro flora & fauna.

 c) 132 KV tower line going through the Umred- Karandala WL Sanctuary. d) Proposed Project of Transmission line is 21.376 Km long ,out of it 3.85 Km is going through the Kuhi (Wlidlife) & Umred (Wlidlife) Range of Umred-Karandala Sanctuary .This project opens the 8.8380 Hact. Area in strip which divides the Kuhi (Wlidlife) Range in two parts.

## Possible Impacts due to this Projects are as following -

- i) Umred-Karandala Wlidlife Sanctuary is the home for many endanged wildlife which listed in schedule -I&II WLPA 1972 gives high level legal protection to them. Removing the trees will definately disturbs habitat for many wildlife.
- ii) Umred-Karandala Wlidlife Sanctuary is proved to be good tiger habitat as such comparatively small area (189.30 Sq. km) is home for 04 adult tigers & 09 Cubs Growing cubs requires more undisturbed space for establishing their own home range. This Project definately affects this.
- iii) Area of Proposed project and its surrounding area of Umred-Karandala Wlidlife Sanctuary is the habitat for one tigress (UK WLS-T3) and two cubs presently and part of Mail Tiger territory of (UK WLS-T1) that Jay When actual project will start, regular movement of these tigress will be badly affected for longer time upto completion of different works under this projects that cutting of trees, its logging operations & transport erection of towers and transports of materials movement of workers. This activity disturbs & moved out prey species as well as predator species also from this area and surrounding area.
- iv) This Sanctuary is spreaded over two distance Kuhi (Wlidlife) & Umred (Wlidlife) range in Nagpur District & Poani Wlidlife in Bhandara District. The work will disturb the connectivity of Nagpur Block with Bhandara Block of the Umred-Karandala Sanctuary, which is the only connectivity. Towords the larges contiguous forest area of Tadoba Andhari TR landscape

- Wildlife movement need to be down to attact the wild animal in same area which will be going to disturb when actual work of implemation
