


Site Inspection Report of Sri Naresh Chandra Singh Munda, J.F.S, Divisional Forest Officer, Medininagar Forest Division.

Site inspection of proposed Govt. Medical College of Village- Pokhrah Khurd, P.s- Daltonganj, Khata no-85, Plot no-1375 (P) is done on 04.12.2015 & 14.12.2015 with representative of the Civil Surgeon cum Chief Medical Officer, Palamu, Sri D.N. Lakra Executive Engineer, Health and Family Welfare Department. Longitude/Latitude of plot is N-24°02' 29.8" E- 84°06'47.3", The record this land is Deemed forest. (Jungle Jhari) therefore seeking prior approval of the State Govt in light of the Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980.

As per the proposal submitted by the Civil Surgeon Cum Chief Medical Officer, Palamau total cost of project is about 30000.00 Lacs and this cost will be bear by the Health and Family Welfare Department, Govt of Jharkhand. This project will generate employment of 300-350 persons in different categories and treatment of the people of the palamau commissary will done, at the some time course for M.B.B.S. will be started after completion of the project which will increase seats of medical students in the Jharkhand State.

This project requires 4.85 hac. Deemed Forest land at Pokhrah Khurd which is G.M. Land (Jungal Jhari). Distance of Purnadih P.F is about 4 kms towards East, Jorkat P.F towards South (about 5kms), Medininagar-Panki (N.H..75) Road (about 1 km) in the North and Kacharwa Dam in the West (about 400 mts). There is no vegetation in the northern part, one palm tree & some bushes of Palash (Butea Monosperma) are available in the southern part of proposed site. Significant presence of wild life in the proposed & nearby area is not reported. There is no any Historical Monuments Archeaological statue are situated near the proposed site. Betla National Park is about 8 kms away from the proposed site. In the field inspection it is found that site of proposed Medical College has been demarcated by erecting 22 nos of R.C.C pillars.

In the above facts & findings proposal of Medical College in the proposed site may be granted for the betterment the people of Palamau Dist.
