

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The proposed site for Four lanning work from km 0 to km 17.3 of NH-37A road passes through the Bhomoraguri R.F. is in the western part of Bhomoraguri RF was inspected on 07/12/2015. There are total 496 nos of standing trees in the proposed diversion area of the Bhomoraguri RF that would require to be felled if the proposed diversion of the RF area is approved. The user agency which has submitted the diversion proposal has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 as they have not started any work on the proposed site.

In the proposed area for diversion, there is no record of rare /endangered/unique species of flora and fauna and also there is no archeological heritage site/ defense establishment or any other important monuments in the area. However, the proposed area for diversion is within approximately 100 Mtrs. from the proposed 6th Addition area of Kaziranga National Park. Moreover, the aerial distance from the proposed site for diversion to the Burachapori WLS is 11.5 km.
