


Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the Road Proposals received from the User Agency i.e.,Executive Engineer Panchayati Raj, Paderu for the road proposed from Theemulabanda to Vadamamidi via Kumkumpudi in G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 10/10/14

Inspected the proposed road from Theemulabanda to Vadamamidi via Kumkumpudi on 10-10-2014 accompanied with Forest Range Officer, R.V.Nagar and Asst. Executive Engineer, PR, G.K.Veedhi. The said proposed road is a kutcha road passing through Kumkumpudi Coffee Estates of APFDC Ltd. and utilizing by the villagers in and around for their day to day movement. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road starts with GPS readings N:17.85159 E.082.18266 and ends at N:17.80694 E.082.15791. The proposed road width is 7 m. and out of 7,273.66 m. of total length of the road, 4,930.45 m. length is passing through Compt. no.1488,1490&1491 of Gudem R.L. with a diversion of 3.46 ha. There are 63 trees falling along the width of Road proposed which are enumerated and enclosed to the proposal. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is varies from 0.1 to 0.4. There are podulands and cultivable lands on either side of the proposed road near Vadamamidi, Kumkumpudi and Theemulabanda locations. The rest of the road is passing through Coffee Estates. The villagers of Kumkumpudi and Vadamamidi are very much need of the improvement of the road for their day to day movement to hospitals and schools for their children and for marketing their agricultural products. This is an essential for the movement of all departments to extend the government activities to all the tribals to bring them in the main stream. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological heritage importance in this locality.
