

Site Inspection Report

(For the forest Land Proposed to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer Bharuch (R&B) Division, Bharuch for permission for diversion (under FCA) of 0.992 Ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose i.e. for widening and strengthening road in Bharuch District in the State of Gujarat. The Site Inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dt. 12-01-2015.

On Inspection of the site it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest and measuring 0.992 ha. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of part-1 is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. No protected, archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monuments is located in the area. No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area. **It is recommended to divert this land for the purpose.**
