


Site Inspection Report

The Improvement of Leni-Akash bridge to NHDL specification between Km 120.00 to 132.00 to 146.70, Ukhrul District, Manipur, was inspected on 31st January, 2015 with the representatives of the User Agency (BRTF).

The total area of 24.03 ha for diversion falls inside the Unclassed Forests. The request for diversion of forest land is unavoidable and barest minimum requirement.

The whole forest area for diversion falls in Sub-Tropical Pine Forest Type. The area has reports of the presence of Schedule I species such as Felis begalensis, Manis crassicaudata, Python spp., Tragopan spp., etc. Common tree species found in the area are Catanopsis hytrix, Quercus spp., Albizzia lebbeck, Pinus kesiya, Schima wallichii etc. There is no archaeological/heritage site, defence establishment or important monuments.

The agency has not done any work in violation of the FCA, 1980 during survey/alignment work and no work has started for up gradation of the road.
