The project envisages the use of forest land for improvement and upgradation of Bahjoi to Gajruala section of State Highway No.-51 from Km 107.000 to Km 137.500 of SH-51 in Amroha (J.P.Nagar) district of Uttar Pradesh.

This site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 26.3.2015

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest land measuring 24.4 ha.




