

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Certified that I have inspected the location of 0.2808 ha. forest land in Fsy.No: TA1A1A1A of Shetgeri village in Ankola Taluka proposed for diversion on lease for formation of approach road to proposed stone quarry which is taken on lease for a period of 4 years for the purpose of extracting boulders to be used for up-gradation and planing of Goa-Karnataka Border to Kundapur section of NH-66 (Km. 93.700 to 93.300) at Shetgeri Malki Sy. No: 310 on 7-03-2015.

The proposed area is having tree growth of species like Anacardium occidentale, Acacia catechu, Mamea Sp, Holligarna Sp, Strycarnos nux vomica, Jungle species. and bamboo clums

The Tree Species which are existing in the proposed road are Anacardium occidentale-20, Acacia catechu-1, Mamea longifolia-1, Holligarna arnottiana-1, Strycarnos nux vomica-1, Jungle wood-2. And bamboo clums19

There are specific fauna viz Panther, Black Panther, are also reported the said locality.

No protected archeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by user agency is unavoidable and least minimum.

There is no Violation of Forest Conservation Act 1980 in proposed area.
