

Site Inspection Report for the proposed construction of C.R.P.F. Camp at Banalat.

The user agency Superintendent of Police, Gumla District has submitted a proposal for the diversion of land for the construction of C.R.P.F. Camp at village – Banalat, P.S.-10, Banalat.

The site was inspected by the undersigned on 30th may 2015. The proposed Camp site is located in village Banalat, P.S. – 10, Plot No. – 186 in an area of 1.6 hec. The proposed site is a G.M (Jungle Jhari) Land. The proposed site is not a notified forest land. During inspection 10 Palash trees (*Butea monosperma*) and 1 (one) Jamun tree (*Syzygium cumini*) were found. The proposed site is an open forest with approx density of 0.2. The proposed site is not adjacent to the notified forest. No protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment or any others important monument is located in the area. There is no National Park and Wild life Sanctuary situated near by the proposed site. During the inspection no rare and endangered plant and wild animal species were found. The site has been selected for the construction of C.R.P.F. Camp is strategically located as per the user agencies. The land requested for the construction of the C.R.P.F. Camp is unavoidable and the barest minimum for the Project, so it is recommended for the diversion of the land.
