**SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF**

A proposal has been received by the Deputy Chief Engineer, LMRC Lucknow for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.13354 hac forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Metro Corridor between Transport Nagar to Charbagh on NH-25 Lucknow-Kanpur road from km 11 to 3. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 04.05.2015

On inspection of the site, 66 trees at the said land are affected.

Land required by the user agency is forest land declared under section-29 of Indian Forest Act-1927 vide notification No. 3208/14, Dt. 23.08.1955 measuring 0.13354 hac. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 part -1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
