

Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the Road Proposals received from the User Agency i.e., Executive Engineer Panchayati Raj, Paderu for the road proposed from Sapparla to Galikonda via Chatrapalli and Jamperlova in G.K.Veedhi Mandal on 05.05.2015

Inspected the proposed road from Sapparla to Galikonda via Chatrapalli and Jamperlova on 05.05.2015 accompanied with i/c Forest Range Officer, R.V.Nagar and Asst. Executive Engineer, PR, G.K.Veedhi and range staff. The said proposed road is a kutchra road, and utilizing by the villagers in and around for their day to day movement. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road starts with GPS readings N:17.93205 E:082.14732 and ends at N:17.90561 E:082.11778. The proposed road width is 7.00 m. and out of 6,497.27 m. of total length of the road, 5,751.81 m. length is passing through Compt. no.1566,1567 & 1568 of Gudem R.L. with a diversion of 4.03 ha. The proposed road was also surveyed with hand GPS and the total length as well as the length of the road falling in RF is tallying with the DGPS surveyed map. There are 02 trees falling along the width of Road proposed which are enumerated and enclosed to the proposal. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the road is 0.1 to 0.4. The villagers of Galikonda, Chatrapalli, Jamparlova, Chinabusikonda, Ginjangi, Pamurugunta, Pebbampalli, Durgam, Gadibandha, Pamurayipakalu and Baknuru are very much need of the improvement of the road for their day to day movement to hospitals, schools for their children and for marketing their agricultural products. This is an essential for the movement of all departments to extend the government activities to all the tribals to bring them in the main stream. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological heritage importance in this locality.
