**FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF SRI K.MAHABOOB BASHA, SFS, DIVISIONAL
FOREST OFFICER, KURNOOL ON 10.03.2015**

Inspected the forest land proposed for diversion for laying of 400 kv Quad Moose double circuit line from Jammalamadugu to Nannoor (Kurnool), of Transmission line passing through Giddalur PF Block and Bethamcherla RF of Kurnool Forest Division on 10.03.2015 along with the Executive Engineer Department official and the Forest Range Officer, Kurnool, Dhone and field staff.

The proposed area for laying of 400 KV Quad Moose double circuit line from Jammalamadugu to Nannoor (Kurnool), Transmission line passing through Giddalur PF Block and Bethamcherla RF of Kurnool Forest Division is passing through the Giddalur CA Block RF and Bethamcherla RF from the Chainage 1.335 Km with a width of 46mts in Giddalur PF Block and 253 mtrs with a width of 46 mts in Bethamcherla RF to  and the proposed transmission line is passing through Giddalur PF Block RF from Northern side to Southern side.

The vegetation in the Reserve Forest in the proposed area to be diverted are Anona Squamosa, Casia fistula, Zizyphus Jujuba, Zizyphus Xylopyrus, Adina cordifolia, Anogeissus latifolia etc., in Giddalur PF Block of Dhone Range and Dodonaea viscosa, Gymnosporia spinosa, Morinda Citrifolia Euphorbia Nivulia Grewia Rotuldifolia, Cassia Fistula, Boda in Bethamcherla RF of Kurnool Range and other thorny species etc., and the density is under ECO – Class III open forest.

The area does not form the part of National Park, Wild Life Sanctuary and there are no Elephant corridors and does not consists of any Archeological & Monumental structures. Further there are no endangered Forest species in the proposed area.
