SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by the Executive Engineer, Provincial Division P.W.D, Lucknow; Distt-Lucknow for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 1.11 hac forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for widening of Lucknow-Sitapur NH-24 Road from km stone (Near Madiyava Police Station) 489 to 493 (Near Naveen Galla Mandi) (right side). The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 9.6.2015.

On inspection of the site, 63 trees at the said land are affected.

Land required by the user agency is forest land declared under section-29 of Indian Forest Act-1927 vide notification No. 3208/XIV, Dt. 23.08.1955 measuring 1.11 hac. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 part -1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project. Details of Protected Forest area is annexed with land schedule separately.


