

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF (For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Easar Oil Ltd., Divisional Office Vibhooti Khand, Gomti Nagar Lucknow For Diversion under FCA-1980 of 0.06677 ha. of Forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Retail Outlet at Sandila-Balamau Road (SH-25) between Km.202-203 on Left side. The Site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on Dated. 30.016.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a PF/Protect forest measuring 0.06677 hac.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
