

Field Inspection Note of Divisional Forest Officer, Bellampally on proposed laying of Water Grid Pipe Line in Segment - 22/17 (Powerguda) in Asifabad and Tiryani Ranges of Bellampalli Division in favour of SE, TDWSP RWS, Nirmal.

I along with concerned staff have inspected the proposed diversion area for Laying of Water Grid Pipe Line **Segment 22/17 (Powerguda)** on 19.07.2016 the proposed pipe line is passing through Asifabad and Tiryani Ranges of this division. The details of Compartment wise Reserve Forest / length / area is as follows.

The proposed Pipe line is passing through the different Reserve Forest with different width which is varying from 0.7 to 4.0 meters and the total length of the pipe line that passing through the Bellampally Division is 14.94 Kms. and the area required for diversion in Bellampally division for Segment 22/17 (Powerguda) is **2.182 Ha.**


In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree found / protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area.

The area is having different type of vegetations, which is having 0.1 to 0.3 Density.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.

No work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.

The laying of Water Grid Pipeline will improve the drinking water facility in the interior areas in LWE District of Adilabad. Hence recommended.
