

**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF SRI G.MUKUND REDDY, FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER,  
KOTHAGUDEM IN RESPECT OF 1.113 HA OF PROPOSED DIVERSION OF FOREST LAND IN  
PENAGADAPA R.F. AND ANNAPUREDDIPALLI RF FOR LAYING OF PIPE LINE CONSTRUCTION  
OF STRUCTURE IN SEGMENT 25/13 (RAMACHANDRAPURAM) IN FAVOUR OF  
SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER, TDWSP (RWS&S) CIRCLE, KHAMMAM ON 21-10-2016**

Inspected the diversion of proposals of 1.113 Ha of forest land in Cimpt.No.32, 34 & 38 of Penagadapa RF and Compt.No.45 of Annapureddipalli RF for laying of pipe line construction of structure in segment 25/13 (Ramachandrapuram) in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam for providing safe drinking water to Aswaraopeta Constituency.

The area required by the User Agency 1.113 Ha is falling in 0.465 Ha in Compt.No.45 of Annapureddipalli RF notified U/s 18 of Hyderabad Forest Act 1 of 1326 Fasli and an area of 0.648 Ha is falling in Compt.No.32, 34 & 38 of Penagadapa RF notified U/s 18 of Hyderabad Forest Act 1 of 1326 Fasli.

The Forest Range Officer, Ramavaram has carried out the survey of Set 1,2, 3 and set wise break-up is shown below.

The width of the pipeline is varying from 0.70 meters to 1.5 meters. The proposed diverted area of forest land falls under scheduled area under Mulakapally Mandal and Chandrugonda Mandal of Aswaraopeta Assembly constituency.

Due to formation of new District Bhadrari and bifurcation of Kothagudem Forest Division the Set No.1 proposed area diverted in Chaparapalli Section of Annapureddipalli RF transferred to Mulakalapalli Range of Forest Divisional Officer, Palvoncha.

**Existing of Tree growth:**

The vegetation of this area comes under Eco class II of Tropical Dry deciduous open forest having density > 0.4. Total trees enumerated are 303 Nos.

**Flora and Fauna**

The existing flora in the proposed diversion of forest is Aogysus latifolia (Tiruman), Manikara hexandra (Pala), Kleestanthus Kollinus (Kodisa), Tectranco Grandis (Teak), Diaspyros melanoxyton (Tuniki), Aylia xeiocarps (Bojja), Chiroxylon Sweitinia (Billudu), Polyathis suberosa (Chilaka duddi).



No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna are found in the proposed diverted forest and as per working plan. However, spotted deer are seen rarely in these areas. There are no unique or endangered flora and fauna.

No protected Archeology/Heritage site and Defence establishment or any other important monuments are located in the proposed area for diversion.

In the proposed forest area no work in violation of Act has been carried out by the User Agency.
