Field Inspection Notes of Divisional Forest Officer, Wildlife Management Division, Warangal to the Forest area which is proposed for diversion of 22.258 Ha. Of Forest Land in Warangal North and Wildlife Management Division, Warangal in favour of SE, TDWSP Circle, Warangal for laying of Pipeline and Constructions of Structures for Segment - 20/3 (Eturnagaram) for Providing Drinking water to Warangal District under Telangana Drinking water supply project on 27.09.2016.

I have inspected the forest land which is proposed for Laying of Pipeline and constructions of Structures for Segment - 20/3 (Eturnagaram) for providing drinking water to Warangal District under Telangana Drinking water Supply project. The proposed area is falling in Compt. No. 104, 105 of Malyal (S), 111 of Kondai (S), 85, 86 of Kondai (N), 64, 67 of Ilapur Beat & 52 of Sarvai (N) Beat of Eturnagaram Wildlife Range and Compt. No. 187 of Tadvai Wildlife Range of Eturnagaram Wildlife Sanctuary. The proposed area is having the forest density of 0.4 to 0.7; (Open Forest)


The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Part - I is noticed unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. During the field inspection it is further noticed that, the area proposed for diversion in the area for diversion as per field verification is **5.710 Ha.**

There is no endangered/rare/unique flora & Fauna exist in the proposed area, there is no protected archaeological heritage site and defense establishment nor any important monument is located in that area.

The existing growth is of species like Nallamaddi, Tiruman, Billudu etc. The enumeration list is test checked and found correct

The area is falling in Eturnagaram Wildlife Sanctuary and not falling in National park, Bio-Sphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve. There is no protected archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monuments is located in the area.

The project is recommended for manual excavation of pipeline for Mission Bhagiradha (Flagship programme of TS Govt. for drinking water) & no machine is to be allowed.
