

SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF THE CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS

The whole stretch of area from Tlabung to Kawrpuiichhuah which was proposed to be diverted for improvement and upgradation of Tlabung – Kawrpuiichhuah road to 2 lane NH standard was inspected by me on 16.11.2016 and I was accompanied by Shri P.C. Laltanpuia, DFO, Tlabung, Shri Pazawna, EE (Highway), PWD, Shri Lalrinmawia, AE (PIU), PWD and Shri K. Zaliana, Range Officer, Tlabung and some other officials.

The project alignment passes through notified forest area at the starting stretch near Tlabung and at the ending stretch near Kawrpuiichhuah. The forest area is of undulating moderate slopes with mostly western aspect. The proposal includes widening of the existing road for 2-laning which will involve removal of several miscellaneous tree species (about 65 nos.), including shrubs, bushes and grasses along the road on the uphill side within the forest land.

The total length of the project alignment which passes through the forest land is 4.15 Km and the total area of forest land to be diverted is 4.98 Ha. There is no archaeological/heritage site, defence establishment or any other important monument or protected area in the proposed area. Also there is no rare and endangered species of wildlife reported in the project area.
