


SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Inspected the project site and the forest land proposed for diversion for the project, along with D.F.O (Noth) Panna. Executive Engineer, WRD ,Panna, S.D.O (forest) Vishramganj on 11.05.2015. The proposed forest land has patchy forests with scanty tree growth having density ranging from 0.1 to 0.3. The main tree species of the affected compartments are Legerstromia parviflora, Tectona gradis having girth class 31-45 cm, 46-60 cm. A large chunk of affected land is under encroachment. Revenue department has also issued patta on the proposed land. Out of 426.763 hector of the land proposed for diversion involving 06 compartments, 48 hector land of the compartment 182 will be submerged, which forms part of the Buffer Zones of Panna Tiger Reserve. The approximate aerial distance of the project area from Ken Ghariyal sanctuary is 7.5 km and from Gangau sanctuary 10 km. The land involved in the project being within 10 km radius of sanctuary and touching to the boundary of the Buffer Zones of Panna Tiger Reserve, appropriate measures to be taken for the conservation of the wild life of the area. Availability of the water in the proposed tank through - out the year, will enhance the water regime of the area in turn will have a positive impact on the vegetation and the wild life. The project being utmost public importance, recommended for sanction.
