The species found are Alangium lamarckil, Terminalia tomentosa, Terminalia bellarica, Bombax Cieba, Chintelugu, Dalberjia latifolia, Mitragyna Parviflora, Lagerstroemia parviflolia, Mahuka indica, Strychnus nuxvomica, Diaspyrus melanoxylon, Delbersia paniculata, Dendrocalamus strictus etc., The enumeration is test checked and found correct.

The area proposed for diversion is not falling in any Sanctuary, National Park, Bio - Sphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve or Elephant corridor. There is no protected archeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monuments is located in the area.
