**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF THE CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS ,CENTRAL CIRCLE, MANIPUR,
OF THE PROJECT AREA WHERE THE PHED DEPARTMENT, MANIPUR PLANS TO TAKE UP
AUGUMENTATION OF WATER SUPPLY SCHEMESFOR THOUBAL(WAITHOUPAT) BY
CONSTRUCTION OF A 6MLD SERVICE RESERVOIR AT TANGJENG HILLS, THOUBAL**

The Tangjeng area where the Public Health Engineering Department, Manipur propose to construct a 6 MLD Service Reservoir for Augumentation of Water Supply Scheme for Thoubal was inspected by me on 15th January, 2016 at around 1.00 p.m. along with the Divisional Forest Officer, Thoubal Forest Division, Manipur and his subordinate staffs.

The forest area to be affected by the project is unclass forest with an average vegetation density of 12% having an area of 0.98 Ha.The area is located inside the compartment No 24 of Yairipok Block under jurisdiction of the Thoubal Range. The area is observed to be moderately prone to erosion. There are few tree growths of species, viz, Quercus serrata, Emblica officinalis, Litsaea polyantha. There are no rare/endangered species of fauna in the area proposed for diversion. Further, the area does not form part of any archeological/heritage site. The forest land proposed for the project is found to be the barest minimum required for the present project and no other suitable land in the surrounding area of the project is available. The site doesn't form any part of the National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary/ Biophere Reserve or part of any protected area area. No protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment is located in the area.

No record of violations of the provisions of the FCA, 1980 committed by the User Agency is observed during the visit.
