The project envisage the use of forest land for construction of Jeera Irrigation Project at village Duanpali. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by Sri Mihir Kumar Biswal, OFS(I) DFO, Bargarh on 10.12.2015. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is 5.391 Ha of revenue forest in Bargarh district.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
