## SITE INSPECTION REPORT

I inspected the area on 29.02.2016. The area is adjacent to Domchanch Mauza, where more than a dozen of stone mines are already running on adjoining non forest land.

The proposed area is almost devoid of vegetation and in the past (long ago) there used to be stone mines on a part of it. Moreover, this area is very prone to illegal mining and regular intensive patrolling is to be done in order to check this menace.

No endangered species of flora and fauna has been found there. There is a very poor vegetation present thereon. List of flora and fauna present around the proposed area is given below:
