

**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF DEPUTY CONSERVATOR OF FOREST, CHITTORGARH
FOR THE FOREST LAND TO BE DIVERTED UNDER FCA**

NAME OF PROJECT:- Chambal Bhilwara Drinking Water Project- Phase - I

The Proposal has been received by this office from PCCF (Hoff) for diversion (under FCA 1980) of 3.1501 ha. forest land in this division for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for drinking water supply. The earlier proposal for the project was for diversion of 0.878 ha, for which final sanction has been issued for Govt. of India vide letter No. 1049 dated 8.10.2014.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 8.4.2016. On inspection of the site, it was found that the land required by the user agency is forest land measuring 3.1501 ha. (1853 meter long X 17 meter wide). The increase in width from 5 mt. to 17 mt. is said to be for 33 KV Transmission Line & service road.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of part-I unavoidable and barest minimum required for the project.

There is no any rare/endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.

There is no any protected archacological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

It has been found that the user agency has not violated the forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 provision. Though the AEN, AVVNL, Bijolia has issued a letter No. 326 dated 11.5.2015 to Ms. Vaibhav Construction, Kota to start the work in forest area of the transmission line, stating that approval has been taken, which was wrong. The AEN, AVVNL, Bijolia & Ms. Vaibhav Constructions, Kota have be informed vide letter No. 6049 dated 6.7.2015 of this office not to start the work of transmission line in the forest area without competent sanction.

Since the project was sanctioned earlier, hence this new revised proposal is recommended for acceptance.
