


Site Inspection Report of Divisional Forest Officer

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA for M/s Ultra Cement Ltd.)

A proposal has been received by this office from M/s Ultra Cement Ltd. of Bihar for diversion (Under FCA-1980) of 0.77 ha of forest land for non forestry purpose for M/s Ultra Cement Ltd. of SH-4 (Construction of R.O.B. (Fatuha, Islampur rail road) length (0.482 KM) in the state of Bihar. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 11th June 2015.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest measuring 0.77 ha. The requirement of Forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I, is unavoidable and is bare minimum required for the project. The land is almost flat and this land is not vulnerable to soil erosion. This land is not a part of any National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary Biosphere Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna are reported to be found in the area. No archeological/heritage site/important monument or defence establishment was seen during the visit of the proposed site. Further, the user agency has not violated the provisions of Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been carried out by the user agency.

Since the project is for use of forest land by M/s Ultra Cement Ltd. of SH-4 (Construction of R.O.B. (Fatuha, Islampur rail road) length (0.482 KM) in the state of Bihar, the land required for the project is very less and is necessary for development of the state, therefore, the required land is recommended for diversion.
