

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT (NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF)

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from South East Uttar Pradesh Power Transmission Company Ltd. Lucknow for diversion 0.460 ha of forest land under FCA- 1980 for non-forestry purpose . The project envisages the use of forest land for construction of 400 KV D/C Manipuri-Aligarh Transmission Line. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 07.06.2016

On inspection of the site, it was found that the land required by the forest land as proposed by the user agencies is a protected forest measuring 0.460 Ha. . The requirement of forest land proposed by the user agencies in col. 2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
