## PROJECT NOTE

JSW Steel Ltd., Dolvi has submitted the proposal for laying of 1100 mm and 400 mm dia. Underground Water pipeline along NH-17 from Patansai (Taluka Roha) to Karav (Taluka- Pen) of District Raigad-Maharashtra. It involved Reserved, Protected and Private Forest area admeasuring to 0.1186 ha.

The project proponent has mentioned in its project note as follows;

"capacity at Dolvi complex is being expanded to attain 10 MTPA integrated steel plant from present 3 MTPA. The plant will be equipped with coke oven complex, pellet plant, sinter plant, blast furnaces, sponge iron plant, ladle furnace, continuous casting facility, hot rolled mill, Bar mill, slap caster oxygen plants, raw material handling system, and jetty expansion for the production of flat products. Present water consumption at Dolvi complex is around 34 MLD. This water is drawn from Amba River Nagothane and pumped to Dolvi complex by 900 mm dia pipe line which was installed in the year 1998-99. The total water requirement for the proposed expansion pr0ject and township will be around 112.16 MLD (4673 Cum/Hr).

To cater this additional water requirement, new water pipeline of 1100 mm dia is being laid from Chikani (Nagothane) to Dolvi complex. The line is routed along National Highway (NH-17) within utility corridor approved by National Highway Authority on RHS from K.M.35.00 to KM 58.00. The pipeline is going to be utilized to cater the increased water requirement of the expanded Dolvi Steel complex of JSW Steel Ltd.

And laying of DN 400 mm dia pipeline in utility corridor of NH-17 (RHS from KM 35.00 to KM 58.00) to meet the drinking water requirement of enroute villages at our cost. Both the pipelines are routed along Natinal Highway (NH-17) within utility corridor approved by National Highway Authority of India on RHS from KM 35.00 to KM 58.00.

Project cost estimated to Rs. 90.00 Crs".

Proposed pipeline has been already laid by the project proponent. Therefore the provisions of forest Conservation Act.1980 and guidelines under it has been violated. The project proponent has accepted the fact and submitted the violation note in prescribed format in proposal.
