The Project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Widening & Strengthening The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 20-08-2016

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a RF/un-leased/Protected forest measuring 27.23 ha.
