
SITE INSPECTION OF ROAD WIDENING PROJECT OF MULAYUR - ALANGANALLUR ROAD IN PERUMALAI RF BY THE CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS, DINDIGUL

inspected the site on 30.8.2016. Thiru.D.Venkatesh, IFS., District Forest Officer, Dindigul, Thiru.P. Bagavathi, Forest Range Officer, Alagarkoil Range and field accompanied me team for the field inspection. Thiru.J.Prem Anand, Assistant Engineer (Highways), Construction Maintenance, Vadipatty and Thiru.S.Baskaran. Road Inspector, Construction and Maintenance, Vadipatty from Highways Department also joined the field inspection.





The road starts from the end of Mulayur village and runs to a distance of 1472 metre inside the RF to cross the RF area. The Highways Department has proposed for 2 metre width for widening the road. During the inspection it was noticed that there are some trees located in the width of 2 metre and in some locations there are some rocky outcrops found in proposed width.

Hence, it was proposed by the District Forest Officer, Dindigul to restrict the additional width to 1.75 metre to avoid tree felling in the RF area. It was verified in the field and found that the recommendations of the District Forest Officer is justified. The issue was then clarified to the accompanied representatives from Highways Department and it was agreed by them also. Hence, it is suggested that as recommended by the District Forest Officer, widening of the road for the project may be recommended for a width of 1.75 metre to a length of 1472 metre in Perumalai RF of Dindigul division. The total area to be diverted for road widening is 0.26 ha.
