I along with Forest Range Officer, Asifabad and staff concerned have inspected the proposed diversion area for proposed Laying of Water Grid Pipe Line **Segment 22/9 (Asifabad)** on 07.07.2016 the proposed pipe line is passing through the following Compartments / Reserve Forest in Asifabad Range.

The proposed Pipe line is passing through the Reserve Forest with different width which is varying from 0.7 to 1.5 meters and 10 Mtrs and the area required for diversion in

Asifabad Range for Segment 22/9 (Asifabad) is **4.158 Ha.** the total length of the pipe line is **20.677 Km.**

In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree found / protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area.

The area is having different type of vegetations, which is having 0.0 to 0.1 Density and trees, poles that come across the proposed pipe line in the forest area enumerated and prepared a list which is enclosed.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.

No work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.

The project is meant for providing safe and protected drinking water to the remote tribal area and that going to solve the acute water problem once for all.
