I have inspected the forest land which is proposed for diversion of 1.6813 Ha of forest land in Karimnagar (East) Division — Formation of Road from Mallaram to Shatrajpally via Chinnatundla and Peddatundla in Karimnagar (District) in favour of Superintending Engineer, PR Circle Karimnagar. The proposed area is falling in Compt No.412 and 413 Shatrajpally Beat of Tadicherla Section of Tadicherla Reserve Forest of Bhupalpally Range. The proposed area comes to 1.6813 Ha with a width of 11.00 meters canopy density (**O***) the main species found are Thiruman, T.Mogili, Kodisa, Maddi, Chennagi, Ippa, Pala, Bilugu, Thiruman etc.,

There is no endangered / rare / unique flora & fauna exist in the proposed area, there is no protected archaeological heritage site and defense establishment nor any important monument is located in that area.

The road proposed by the User Agency is to upgrade the existing cart track road into a black top road.

The dimensions of the road proposed are

Length: 1529.24 M.

Width: 11.00 Meters

Which consists of black top road width = 1529.24 Meters

This road is used for connecting only the villages of Mallaram to Shatrajpally via Chinnatundla and Peddatundla these villages have existing black top road already existing and this is part of a dense forest with canopy density of about under these circumstances the road can be recommended

The requirement of forest land proposed by the user Agency is unavoidable and bare minimum to take up for improvement of Road from Mallaram to Shatrajpally via Chinnatundla and Peddatundla Karimnagar (District) The proposed project will not adversely affect any flora and fauna.
