

**Field Inspection Note of Divisional Forest Officer, Bellampally on proposed Laying of Water Grid Pipe Line in Segment-22/5 (Dahegaon) in Kushnepally Range of Bellampally Division in favour of SE, TDWSP RWS, Circle Nirmal.**

I along with Forest Range Officer, Kushnepally, Forest Section Officer, Rampur and concerned staff have inspected the diversion area proposed for Laying of Water Grid Pipe Line in **Segment 22/5 (Tandur)** on 02.05.2016 the proposed pipe line is passing through the following Compartments / Reserve Forest in Kushnepally Range of this division, the details of which is as follows.

The proposed Pipe line is passing through the Reserve Forest with different widths from 0.7 to 1.0 meters and the area required for diversion in for Segment 22/5 (Dahegaon) is **2.421 Ha.** the total length of the pipe line that passing through the Reserve Forest in Bellampally Forest Division is 33.568 Kms.




In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree found / protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area.

The area is having different type of vegetations, with 0.3 Density.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.

No work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.

The laying of Water Grid Pipeline will improve the drinking water facility in the interior Tribal areas in LWE District of Adilabad. Hence, it is recommended for considering the proposal.
