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FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF SRI.G.KISTA GOUD, SFS., DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, WARANGAL (SOUTH) DIVISION ON DT: 21.04.2016.

I have inspected the proposed forest area proposed for Improvements the road from Km 121/0 to Km 154/0 of Nakrekal to Mallampally of NH-365 in being taken up by Executive Engineer (R&B), National Highways Division, Warangal on 21-04-2016. It is falling in Jamandlapally Reserve Forest in Compt.Nos.1223, 1224, 1225 of Jamandlapally Beat of Jamandlapally Section of Mahabubabad Range and Guduru and Guduru-I Reserve Forests in Compt.No.990 of Macherla Beat of Macherla Section, Compt.No.1002 of Guduru Beat of Guduru Section, Compt.No.1036, 1037 of Ponugodu Beat, Compt.No.1044 of Bhupathipet Beat of Bhupathipet Section of Guduru Range. The length of the Road in Forest is 17.104 Kms and width is 13 Mtrs (the existing road width is 12.00 Mtrs and the same is proposed for widening to a width of 25.00 Mtrs).The proposed area having the forest of 0.40 density. 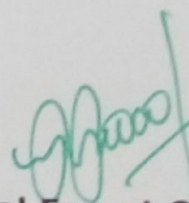
Out of the total area proposed for diversion of 24.80 Ha, an area of 20.53 Ha is falling in Pakhal Wildlife Sanctuary and the remaining area of 4.26 Ha is falling in Reserve Forest area of Jamandlapally Beat & Section of Mahabubabad Range.
