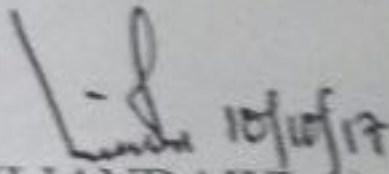


SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF NODAL OFFICER (Dt.06.10.2017)

On date 6th October 2017 (Friday) accompanied by the Conservator of Southern Circle, Lunglei Mizoram, DCCF of LADC, Lawngtlai, DCCF of MADC, Saiha I had made physical site inspection of the forest areas within the LADC and MADC which are required for diversion in the upcoming proposed project for widening and upgradation of NH-54 (Aizawl-Tuipang Road) to double-lane with paved shoulder and geometric improvements.

Within the two Autonomous District Council areas of Lai & Mara the total area of forest land required for diversion comes to about 11.20 Ha. (approx) which will require removal of several trees of natural and Gov't. plantation which are already being enumerated by the concerned officials of the areas for assessment. These proposed areas for diversion has no rare or endangered species of flora or fauna. There are no heritage archeological sites nor defence establishment that could negatively be affected by this current project.

Diversion of the plots falling within the two Autonomous District Councils as above is recommended as there are not alternate or better option.
