SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from **Development of Purvanchal Expressway Via Lucknow, BaraBanki, Amethi, Faizabad, Sultanpur, Ambedkarnagar, Azamgarh, Mau & Ghazipur** for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 1.3691 ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose in Ghazipur District. The project envisages the use of forest land for Construction of Road, Service Road.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated **12.10.2017**

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest measuring **1.3691 ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the retail outlet project.

(A) The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction. Yes

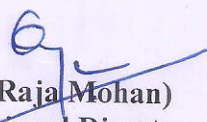
