

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A Proposal has been received by this office from DEPUTY CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, UPEIDA, LUCKNOW for Construction Purvanchal Expressway via Lucknow under (FCA-1980) of 0.4560 Ha. of protected forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for Samajwadi Purvanchal Expressway construction in Village-Maghua, Lucknow-Sultanpur Railway Line (Between Km. 1030/10 to Km. 1030/11) Tehsil-Mohanlalganj, District-Lucknow. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on **dated 11-10-17**.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a RF/un-
classified/Protected forest measuring 0.4560 Ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.


