

Inspection note, finding and recommendation with reasons

The proposed site was inspected on 29-08-2017. The Deputy Conservator of Forest & subordinate staffs were present and assisted during inspection. The factual details regarding the proposed site and consequent findings are stated below:-


1. The proposal is for widening & strengthening of Biraul- Singhia road from km 10.00 to 13.10 (Total length 3.10 km) in the Darbhanga district. The proposed road originates from SH- 88 at singhia in Samastipur district and meets Beri Chowk of SH- 56 in Darbhanga district.
2. The latitude & longitude of the proposed site is 25.861589° N & 25.855939° N to 86.229800° E & 86.256843° E.
3. The user agency proposed for diversion of 4.8856 Ha of forest land which is notified as protected forest vide notification no. 190 E Dated 16.02.1994.
4. There are only 137 trees of different species present on the proposed site. There are no rare/endangered/unique species of flora & fauna found in the area. There is one monument "Singheswar Sthan " at about 12 km. from the origin point (Singhia) in Darbhanga district.
5. The user agency has not done any work on the proposed site. Due to flood water logging was on both side of the existing road.

On the basis of recommendation of the Deputy Conservator of Forest and the inspection done by me. The proposal may be accepted on the following reasons:-

1. In order to speedy and frequent movement of vehicle, the proposal is very useful as it connects both Darbhanga & Samastipur district. It will also help to connect rest of the district area in case of any worst situation as the connecting area is flood prone.
2. The density of the road side protected forest is low. The acceptance of the proposal, as it entails, provision of compensatory afforestation along the road side, as it customary, may help to increase forest density & green cover.
3. The forest area involved in this project is 4.8856 Ha.
