SITE INSPECTION REPORT

On 14.05.2017, I inspected the proposed site of Bherbheri-2 Sand Mahal along with the Range Officer and his staff, Kulsi Range. The proposed site of I ha area is located in the riverbed of Kulsi river which divides the Kulsi and Pantan RF in midstream under Kulsi Range. The following GPS coordinates of the proposed area were verified and found correct. There is considerable quantity of sand in the proposed area and extraction of the sand will not harm the local flora and fauna or the river course of the Kulsi river. And there are no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna as well as no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment in the proposed area. Moreover, as the aforesaid area is in the riverbed hence the apprehension of damages to natural vegetation doesn't arise and there are no works carried out in violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

Under these circumstances, I do hereby recommend the diversion proposal of 1 ha area for extraction of minor mineral (sand).
